#### **Online Missionary Training**

I've completed the first section of the training to be an online missionary with GMO. GMO is a section of Campus Crusade for Christ or now know as "Cru". I will be part of the Israel Specialty Community, and will be interacting online through e-mails with Jewish people who are interested in learning more about Jesus or have become new Jewish Christians. Pray for this great opportunity to help Jesus become disciples of Jesus. There is a lot of material to absorb in the training, so pray for God's grace of retention and concentration as I study and handle online contacts. Part of the training is to respond to actual contacts that have requested help or prayer.

#### **Thursday Bible Study**

Last week I led the Thursday Bible study with 6 Jewish people. We had a new person attending named Estelle. I covered the basics of the Gospel using mostly O.T. verses and ending with Isaiah 53. The people kept the Scripture notes. Pray for God to open their eyes to be able to respond to truth.

#### **Retirement Home Sermon**

Last Sunday, I preached a sermon at Willow Lake Retirement home. There were about 15 people in attendance. I focused on the theme Who is Jesus, and How Can He Help Us? At the end of the sermon, I included a prayer of confession which the people had a copy of. They recited the prayer with me and then a prayer of assurance. Pray that if any among them had not opened their hearts to the Lord before, God used these prayers to bring them into His Kingdom or closer to salvation.

#### **New Skilled Nursing Home Opportunity**

Jackie is is receiving physical therapy at Willow Ridge Center in Hatboro (3485 Davisville Rd.). While visiting her I spoke to their activity director and requested the opportunity to lead a Bible discussion twice a month. It turns out the director was raised as a Christian and was very happy to accommodate me. The study will be billed as a non-denominational discussion of the Bible with the hope that both believers and non-believers will attend. The center has many Jewish people who either live there, or are getting therapy. Pray for the Lord to bless this new outreach.

## **Ice Water Leads to a Witness of the Living Water**

On one of the hottest days this year (100 degrees) the Jay Sharfenberg called me and asked me to join him in giving out bottles of cold water at a busy stop near a large mall. We hauled a chest full of ice and water to the bus stop, and began giving out water in the name of Jesus. Eventually I sat down on a bench next to a young man named Tom. I struck up a conversation with him and learned that he studying how to create computer games. I asked who did he believe Jesus is (I use the present tense because Jesus is ALIVE). Even though he was wearing a cross, he quietly said Jesus was a man who did good things. I explained that He was more than a man, and began to give a full explanation of the Gospel, and of testimony of answered payer. Praise the Lord, the bus didn't come for a while, and we were able to have a fifteen-minute conversation. I encouraged Tom to read the Gospel of John and gave him my contact information. Pray Tom will read John and get back in touch with me.
